
ICHIRO SUZUKI





Ichiro Suzuki was born in October 22, 1973 and is a Japanese professional baseball outfielder. With 26 seasons combined in top-level professional leagues, he has spent the bulk of his career with two teams: nine seasons with the Orix Blue Wave of Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB) in Japan, where he began his career, and 12 with the Seattle Mariners of Major League Baseball (MLB) in the United States.

CAREER

- He became the best rookie award in 2002.
- When he was 42-year-old he had hit a record of 4,257 career hits -- 1,278 in Japan and 2,979 in Major League Baseball.
- Ichiro Suzuki became the first player age 42 or older to go 4-for-4 or better in a game.

FAMOUSE

He is famous because he is an all round plyer.
he has hit 4,257 career hits, has won 10th straight Gold
Glove for a full season of fielding excellence, and has even
stolen over 500 bases by passing Jackie Robinson's
